

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING THE REVISED COMMON LECTIONARY (RCL)

Who prepares and publishes the Lectionary Card?

The Lectionary Card is produced jointly by the Uniting Church National Assembly Working Group on Worship and MediaCom Education Inc. The Card is printed and distributed by MediaCom (phone 1800 811 311)

When is the Card published?

It is usually available by the beginning of October each year

Where else can the RCL be accessed?

There are a number of websites that provide versions of the RCL.

One of the best is the Vanderbilt Divinity Library site
This site offer the whole three-year lectionary, allowing for long-term planning

2012-2013	Year C (Luke)
2013-2014	Year A (Matthew)

Then the cycle repeats
Readings from the Gospel of John are included every year
